### Terms and Conditions:

I agree to the following terms in connection with the loan of one yard debris dumpster from College Acres Public Works District and affirm that I am a legal resident of the District.

1. Length of loan: 48 hours starting from date of delivery.
2. Price: free to the Districts residents. All others pay a rental fee.
3. ***Restriction on Material placed in Dumpster: I represent and warrant that the materials placed in the dumpster shall not include any of the items on Schedule A to this Form – Unacceptable items in residential Dumpster.***
4. Only yard debris consisting of leaves, pine straw, and limbs will be placed in the Dumpster.
5. I agree to comply with all Aiken County ordinances and regulations contained in Chapter 10-1 thru 10-56 and College Acres Public Works District Resolution 2004-95.

### **Schedule A- Unacceptable Items In Residential Yard Debris Dumpsters**

#### **Do not put the following items in the rental dumpster:**

Antifreeze  
Appliances, washer machines, dishwashers, water heaters  
Asbestos in any form including asbestos shingles  
Batteries: lead acid, automobile and household  
Bio-hazard and medical waste, and red bag waste  
Chemicals, including pesticides, pool chemicals, fertilizers  
Concrete, bricks, and blocks.  
Electronics of any kind  
Explosives  
Fluorescent light bulbs, ballasts and batteries  
Sofas or couches  
Lawn and garden chemicals and other household liquids and chemicals  
Mercury containing products or appliances  
Leaves in plastic bags (cannot see what is in the bag)  
Mercury containing products or appliances  
Paints and solvents  
PCB's  
Petroleum Products  
Propane cylinders or other pressurized tanks, empty or full  
Radioactive and nuclear waste  
Recyclable materials  
Refrigeration units including dehumidifiers, air conditioners, freezer, etc.  
Rock, soils, and dirt  
Tar  
Thermostats  
Tires of any kind  
Used motor oil filters  
Waste oils, gas cans, and free liquids  
Wood longer than five feet (5') in length

***Any of these items found in the Dumpster must be removed before the dumpster is taken to the landfill and addition fees will be charged as determined by the College Acres Public Works District.***
